- a. You must supply a photo and artist statement
- b. You must sign a disclosure agreement releasing the venue from any liability
- c. You must submit an image of your donated piece into the live auction with: Title, Size, Medium, and Value of piece

### 4. Show Set up and Display

- a. All art must be brought to the Braxton Condominiums Thursday, June 6th between the hours of 4pm to 7:30 pm.
- b. All artists must be present at the Gala, Friday June 7th from 5:30 to 10pm
- c. 2d artists must provide their own easels for exhibiting their work
- d. 3d artists must provide any cloths, pedestals, and whatever means necessary for proper display of their work. Some flat surfaces may be available for display...TBD.















#### 5. Art Sales

Sold art from the exhibition will have all payments going through the Art League with 20% being paid to the Braxton and the 80% balance will be paid to the artist. #### 6. LIVE AUCTION DONATIONS

- a. It is encouraged, *but not mandatory*, If ANY ART LEAGUE MEMBER (displaying or not) wish to donate any "original" or GREAT PRINT of their art into the live auction, there will be an agreement form that must be completed indicating: value of piece, size, title, medium, and a release for the donation to the Art League of Cheatham County. You may submit any number of pieces to help raise funds for the Art League and Scholarships. Live auction items will be featured in a brochure.
- b. An Auctioneer will present the live auction. The 2022 Fall Gala was a spirited event and raised nearly \$8,000! c. Member Artists, whether exhibiting or not, who donate a piece of their art into the Live Auction will have their name entered into the raffle TO WIN CASH...TBA

#### 7. Show Tickets & Poolside VIP Reception!!! IMPORTANT!!!

- a. Tickets for general admission will be \$40 purchased in advance, and \$55 at the door. Poolside VIP Reception will be \$100 per ticket. An on line purchase platform of tickets will announced by May 20th.
- b. GALA exhibiting artists will have no charge for the VIP and may have one additional family member attendee for a reduced rate of \$25 ea. Exhibiting artists may display one piece in the Penthouse and cannot be any larger than 18 x 24.
- c. Our **SPONSORED VIP POOLSIDE RECEPTION** There will be an accomplished pianist, specialty beverages and hors d'oeuvres at no additional cost.

#### 8. Show Breakdown and Removal of Art

a. Show breakdown may begin at 10pm and must be out by 11pm, Friday evening June 7th. Or, art may also be removed between 10am – noon on Saturday, June 8th. Any art left after that will become property of the Braxton HOA.
